

Abstract of the Will of William Hawken of the Parish of St. Ervan in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 28 Nov 1819, proved 5 Jun 1824.

Gives £5 to **his daughter Ann Key wife of James Key**.

Gives £15 to **his son William Hawken**.

Gives £5 to **his son Thomas Hawken**.

Gives 1 shilling to **his son John Hawken**.

Gives £30 to **his daughter Mary Key, widow**, and £5 to **her daughter Ann**.

The above legacies are to be paid out of his leasehold tenement called Treginegar Milk and Meadow.

Gives an annuity of £4 to **his daughter Sarah Hellyar wife of John Hellyar**.

The remainder of his estate called Treginegar Milk and Meadow he gives to **his sons Joseph Hawken and James Hawken**, appointing them co-executors of his will.
