Abstract of the Will of John Henwood of the Borough of Helston in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 10 Dec 1758, proved 28 Jan 1759.

Gives to **his brother Joseph Henwood** an annuity of £5, along with all his clothing. Gives £10 to Mrs. Mary Miller.

All the rest of his lands, tenements, goods & chattels he gives, devises & bequeaths in trust to John Trewren, Esq., Thomas Glynn, Esq., and Richard Johns the Younger, gent., for the benefit of **his daughter Ann Henwood**, then underage. If his daughter should die before turning twenty-one, he wills, devises and bequeaths the same to **his brother Joseph Henwood** and to **his sister the wife of William Courtis**.

Appoints his trustees co-executors of his last will and testament.
