Abstract of the Will of Alice Hockin of the Parish of Illogan in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 4 Feb 1784, proved 9 May 1786.

Gives to **her grandchildren**, namely **Anne Hockin, Charles Hockin, Alice Hockin, Blanch Hichins, Grace Hockin, Jane Hockin, Benjamin Hockin, Mary Hockin** and **Richard Hockin**, **sons and daughters of her late son Benjamin Hockin**, her part of Tregagorran otherwise known as Tregagorran Waters or North Tregagorran, share and share alike.

Appoints **her daughter Blanch Rickard** sole executrix of her last will and testament, giving her all her lands and tenements for the term of her natural life, after which the same goes to **her children**, namely **John Rickard, Grace Rickard** and **Alice Rickard**.
