

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/H/7059 W.

Abstract of the Will of George Hocking of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Husbandman, written 6 Apr 1799, proved 19 May 1800.

Gives to **his son George Hocking** one third of all his effects.

Gives to **his daughter Mary Hocking** one third of all his effects.

Gives to **his daughter Jane the wife of William Menadue** one third of all his effects.

Gives 1 shilling to **his wife Joanna Hocking**.

Gives 1 shilling each to **his sons-in-law James Jenking and Henry Jenking**.

Gives to his three children all his goods, chattels and estates, share and share alike.

If **his grandson William Menadue, son of William Menadue and his daughter Jane**, outlives his mother, then he is to have her share.

Appoints **his daughter Jane the wife of William Menadue** sole executrix in trust for **his two children George and Mary Hocking**.
