

Abstract of the Will of John Hollow of Tendrine in the Parish of Zennor and County of Cornwall, Farmer, written 29 May 1801, proved 14 Dec 1809.

Gives an annuity of £12 to **his wife Catherine Hollow** for life. Also gives her half his house in Tendrine where he now lives.

Gives to **his son Thomas Hollow** his estate in Bospreaes in the parish of Zennor.

Gives to **his son Matthew Hollow** his estate in Boswednan in Zennor.

Gives £10 to **his daughter Catherine Perry**.

Gives £10 to **his daughter Elizabeth Quick**.

Gives £10 to **his daughter Jane Christopher**.

Gives £5 to **his granddaughter Catherine Perry**.

Gives to **his son John Hollow** his estate in Tendrine along with any other property not already bequeathed, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
