Abstract of the Will of Nicholas Kempe of Rosteage in the Parish of Gerrans in the County of Cornwall, written 6 Sep 1754, proved 16 May 1768.

Gives all his lands, tenements and hereditaments to **his brother Charles Kempe** of Carsillask, gent. and **his sister Ursula Kempe** of Rosteage, spinster, in trust, to pay his debts and those of **his father Arthur Kempe**.

Appoints his siblings Charles Kempe and Ursula Kempe co-executors of his last will and testament.

Gives £900 to **his three daughters Mary, Dorothy and Ursula**, to be equally divided between them.

Notes in a codicil dated 24 Jun 1765 that his daughter Dorothy has since married to Mr. William Bedford, clerk, and voids her bequest, giving £600 to Mary and Ursula.
