Abstract of the Will of James Kempthorne of the Borough of Helston in the County of Cornwall, War Admiral of His Majesty's Navy, written 22 Nov 1806, proved 23 Sep 1808.

Gives and devises to his two sons the Rev. John Kempthorn and James Kempthorn his freehold tenement, garden, stable and premises in the borough of Helston in trust, for the benefit of his wife Eleanor Kempthorne and daughter Eleanora Kempthorne.

Gives to his wife the use of all the household furniture and utensils, plate, china and linen during her widowhood, passing thereafter to **his** said **daughter Eleanora**.

Confirms the legacy of £200 per annum to his wife from her father.

Gives an annuity of 12 guineas to his niece Jane Polwin the widow of Thomas Polwin, for the term of her natural life.

All the rest of his goods, chattels, rights, credits and effects he gives to **his sons John Kempthorne** and **James Kempthorne**, as tenants in common, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
