

Abstract of the Will of Renatus Kempthorne of the Parish of Mullion in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 8 Jul 1774, proved 8 Jun 1776.

Gives an annuity of £25 to **his wife Elizabeth Kempthorne** for the term of her natural life.

Gives an annuity of £15 to **his son Edward Kempthorne** for the term of his natural life.

Gives £100 each to **his sons William and John Kempthorne**.

Gives 1 guinea to **his daughter Elizabeth**.

Gives to **his eldest son Renatus Kempthorne** the younger and his heirs all his lands, tenements and hereditaments in the parish of Mullion and in the town of Falmouth, both in co. Cornwall.

All the rest of his worldly goods, leasehold estates, chattels and effects he gives to his said son Renatus Kempthorne, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
