

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: SO/W/648.

Abstract of the Will of Thomas Key of Bodellick in the Parish of St. Breock in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 14 Mar 1843, proved 28 Apr 1843.

Gives an annuity of £10 to **his daughter Anne Paynter wife of William Paynter** in case she becomes a widow.

Gives to **his son Silvester Key** his freehold estate, lands and tenements called Martins Hills and Kite Meadow in the parish of St. Breock.

All the rest of his freehold and personal estate (except the property he has already given to his children by Deeds of Settlement) he gives to **his son Silvester Key** and his heirs, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.

Effects under £100.

Testator died 12 Apr 1843.
