Abstract of the Will of Stephen Knight of the Parish of Illogan in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 26 Apr 1800, proved 1 Sep 1802.

Gives £50 to **his wife Grace Knight** and sufficient household furniture with which to furnish two rooms.

All the rest of his real and personal estate he gives to **his brother John Knight, his son-in-law Andrew Vivian**, and Peter Pendarves, gentleman, in trust, to sell and invest in government or other good securities, paying the interest and dividends paying to his wife and, following her death, paying the principal and interest to **his children John Knight, Stephen Knight, Frances Vivian, Grace Knight and Prudence Knight**.

Appoints his said trustees co-executors of his last will and testament.
