Abstract of the Will of Mary Lanyon of Gwinear in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 9 Jun 1728, proved 10 Nov 1737.

Gives to **her son Tobias Lanyon** a broad piece of gold valued at 20 shillings.

Gives to **her son John Lanyon** a broad piece of gold valued at 20 shillings.

Gives £40 to **her son Henry Lanyon**.

Gives 5 shillings to **her daughter Dorothy Lanyon**.

Gives 20 shillings to the poor of the parish of Gwinear.

All the rest of her goods and chattels she gives to **her daughters Mary the wife of Hugh Ley** of Redruth and **Elizabeth the wife of John Collins** of Breage, and appoints the co-executrices of her last will and testament.
