*Abstract of the Will of Tobias Lanyon of Lanyon in the Parish of Gwinear in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 23 Aug 1718, proved 26 Apr 1721.*

Gives £5 to **his son Tobias Lanyon**.

Gives £5 to **his daughter Mary now the wife of the Reverend Mr. Hugh Ley**, rector of Redruth.

Gives £300 each to **his sons and daughters, John Lanyon and Henry Lanyon, Dorothy Lanyon and Elizabeth Lanyon**.

Gives, devises and bequests to **his brothers-in-law the Rev. Mr. John Penneck**, chancellor of the cathedral church at Exeter, **Mr. Francis Penneck** and **Mr. Charles Penneck**, to his wife, and to his friend Mr. Benjamin Sperton, all his lands and tenements commonly called Coswyn als. Polwheele in Gwinear, to hold in Trust for his said children.

Appoints **his wife Mary Lanyon** sole executrix of his last will and testament.
