Abstract of the Will of Tobias Lanyon of Lanyon the County of Cornwall, written 5 May 1755, proved 15 Jul 1762.

Gives to his son Hugh an annuity of £20 for the term of his life.

Gives £300 to his daughter Mary.

Gives £300 each to his children Richard, Edward, William and Jane.

Gives £50 to his grandson, son of **late son Tobias**, to be paid to him when he reaches the age of 15 years.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to **his wife Prudence** and to his friend Thomas Glynn Esq., appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
