Gives £150 to each of his said daughters.

Gives £150 to his daughter Mary the wife of Peter Roskilly of Marazion.

Gives £150 to his daughter Grace Millett, spinster, who currently lives with his brother Leonard Millett.

All the rest of his goods and chattels, lands and tenements, he gives to **his only son, Robert Millett** the younger, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
