

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/644/241.

Abstract of the Will of Constance Nettle of the Town of Penzance in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 6 Mar 1730/1, proved 15 May 1731.

Gives to **her eldest daughter Catharine the wife of Edward Langford**, Gent. the tenement and lands called Bands in the parish of St. Agnes in co. Cornwall, which formerly belonged to her husband deceased.

Gives to her said daughter Catharine Langford her silver tankard and wedding ring.

Gives to **her daughters Mary Nettle and Margaret Nettle** all her household goods, share and share alike.

Gives £200 each to **her daughters Mary Nettle and Margaret Nettle**.

All the rest of her goods and chattels, real and personal estate, she gives to her three daughters aforesaid, to be equally divided between them.

Appoints her three daughters co-executrices of her last will and testament.
