Abstract of the Will of John Nettle of the Town of Penzance in the County of Cornwall, Shopkeeper, written 15 Oct 1710, proved 23 Jan 1710/1.

Gives 50 guineas of gold to **his wife Constance Nettle**, over and above a tenement of land called Bands in the parish of St. Agnes in co. Cornwall already settled on her by deed.

Gives 1 guinea of gold to **his sister Sedwell Tregea**.

All the rest of his goods and chattels, lands and tenements, he gives to **his three daughters Katherine, Mary and Margaret**, share and share alike, appointing them co-executrices of his last will and testament.

Appoints as overseers of his will his wife and friends Symon Tregea of St. Agnes, Gent. and Nicholas Pearce of Penzance, Gent., during the minorities of his daughters.
