Abstract of the Will of Thomas Nicholls of the Parish of Lower St. Columb in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 4 May 1801, proved 8 Mar 1803.

Gives £20 to **his daughter Elizabeth Martyn**, widow.

Gives £50 to **his daughter Mary the wife of Constantine Bradford**.

Gives to **his daughter Mary Bradford** an additional £100, provided and in case her husband the said Constantine Bradford releases to **his son James Nicholls** and his heirs the fee and inheritance of Dyers Tenement in Treveglos, Lower St. Columb.

Gives £10 to **his grandson John Nicholls Martyn**.

Gives £10 to **his grandson William Martyn**.

Gives £50 to **his grandson James Martyn**.

Gives £40 to **his granddaughter Elizabeth Jane Martyn**.

Gives £40 to **his granddaughter Mary Martyn**.

Gives £30 to **his granddaughter Mary Nicholls**.

Gives £50 to **his grandson James Nicholls**. Also gives to James the bedstead, cotton furniture and bedding in the parlour chamber.

Gives £2 2s. each to **his grandchildren Elizabeth Johns, Samuel Martyn, Edward Martyn, Thomas Nicholls and John Nicholls**.

All the rest of his real or freehold estate, lands and hereditaments, goods, chattels and personal estate, he gives to **his son James Nicholls**, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
