Abstract of the Will of Richard Oats of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Miner, written 13 Aug 1839, proved 22 May 1844.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Grace**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Elizabeth**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Azariah**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Mary**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Ann**.

Gives £1 to **his son Richard**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his son Joseph**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Honor**.

Gives to **his daughter Alice** 20 shillings, to be paid to her once his youngest child turns twenty-one.

Gives to **his sons John and William** and to **his daughter Alice** the produce of his land and the use and occupation of his land, household furniture, on the condition that they allow their sister Honor to dwell in the house with them, if she should choose to do so.

Appoints **his sons John and William** co-executors of his will and testament. If one of them should die, then he appoints **his son Martin** in their place.
