Gives to **his wife Joane** the other half of the said tenement of Tresprisson for the term of her natural life, along with £60.

Appoints his friends Jaspar Phillips of Phillack, clerk, and Thomas Glyn of Polkinghorne, gent, guardians and trustees of his son during his minority.

Appoints **his son Bennett Pascoe** sole executor of his last will and testament. (signed)

An inventory of the goods & chattels of Bennet Pascoe of the parish of Wendron, yeoman, was appraised 4 Aug 1686 by John Harry and Robert Cocke and valued at £61 11s. 2d.
