Abstract of the Will of William Paull of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 1 Aug 1826, proved 11 Jun 1828.

Gives £50 to **his son William Paull** the younger.

Gives £100 to **his daughter Catherine the wife of Edward Angove.**

Gives £50 to **his daughter Jenny the wife of John Burrall.**

Gives £50 to **his daughter Elizabeth the wife of John Slater.**

Gives 5 shillings to **his son James Paull.**

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Josiah Paull.**

Gives £1 1s. each to **his grandchildren Mary, Grace and Alexander Paull, daughters and son of his late son Alexander Paull.**

Gives to **his daughter Grace Paull** his part and interest in Camborne Veor, along with his dwelling house in Camborne Town with the household furniture, so long as she lives with her mother until the time of her decease.

Gives 1 guinea to **his daughter Mary Bryant.**

Following the death of his wife he gives to **his children Catherine, Jenny, Mary, William, Elizabeth and Josiah**, his estate, term and interest in the tenement of Roskear in the parish of Camborne, as tenants in common, held under lease from Edward William Wynne Pendarves, Esq.

Gives to **his wife Grace Paull** his said part of the tenement of Roskear and the dwelling house in Camborne Town.

All the rest of his goods, chattels, household furniture, &c. he gives to his said wife, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
