

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/449/257.

Abstract of the Will of Peter Pendarves of the Parish of Gwynnnier [Gwinear] in the County of Cornwall, written 25 Apr 1698, proved 9 Feb 1699.

Gives 1 guinea of gold each to **his son Richard Pendarves, Richard's wife Ann Pendarves**, and **their daughter Katherine Pendarves**.

Gives £40 to **his granddaughter Katherine Gartrell**.

Gives £5 each to **his grandchildren Richard Gartrell, Thomas Gartrell and Elizabeth Gartrell**.

Gives a guinea of gold to **his sister Anne Jeffryes** of Crowan.

Gives a guinea of gold each to **his sister-in-law Mary Pendarves of London, widow**, and **her children Stephen Pendarves**, merchant, and **Mary the wife of Samuel Kekewich**, merchant.

Gives 10 shillings to the poor of the parish of Gwinear.

Gives to his servant John Hoskin a horse called 'Luke'.

Gives to his maid servant Mary Bone one heifer.

Names **his daughter Elizabeth now the wife of Otho Glyn**, gent. as beneficiaries of £100 in lieu of a marriage portion.

Appoints **his daughters Katherine Gartrell**, widow, **Sarah the wife of Nicholas Carveth**, gent, and the said **Elizabeth the wife of Otho Glyn**, gent, co-executrices of his last will and testament, making them residuary legatees.
