Abstract of the Will of Peter Pendarves of the Parish of Gwynnnier [Gwinear] in the County of Cornwall, written 25 Apr 1698, proved 9 Feb 1699.

Gives 1 guinea of gold each to his son Richard Pendarves, Richard's wife Ann Pendarves, and their daughter Katherine Pendarves.

Gives £40 to his granddaughter Katherine Gartrell.

Gives £5 each to his grandchildren Richard Gartrell, Thomas Gartrell and Elizabeth Gartrell.

Gives a guinea of gold to his sister Anne Jeffryes of Crowan.

Gives a guinea of gold each to his sister-in-law Mary Pendarves of London, widow, and her children Stephen Pendarves, merchant, and Mary the wife of Samuel Kekewich, merchant.

Gives 10 shillings to the poor of the parish of Gwinear.

Gives to his servant John Hoskin a horse called 'Luke'.

Gives to his maid servant Mary Bone one heifer.

Names his daughter Elizabeth now the wife of Otho Glyn, gent. as beneficiaries of £100 in lieu of a marriage portion.

Appoints his daughters Katherine Gartrell, widow, Sarah the wife of Nicholas Carveth, gent, and the said Elizabeth the wife of Otho Glyn, gent, co-executrices of his last will and testament, making them residuary legatees.
