*Abstract of the Will of Christopher Pender of Penzance in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 5 Feb 1714/5, proved 8 May 1716.*

Gives his dwelling house with all appurtenances to **his wife Jaqueline Pender** and **daughter Joan Pender** for life. After their deaths, he gives the same to **his son Oliver Pender** and his heirs.

Gives all of his household goods, his bills and notes for money, all debts on the shopbook and goods in the shop to his said wife and daughter.
