Abstract of the Will of Bridget Penneck of Tregimba within the Parish of St. Hilary in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 23 Feb 1715/6, proved 25 Oct 1716.

Gives £50 to her son William Penneck.

Gives £20 to **her son Francis Penneck**, and an additional £10 to cover all rents pertaining to Nanjenking Mills otherwise known as Godolphin Mills.

Gives £100 to her son Charles Penneck.

Gives £100 to her daughter Mary Lanyon.

Gives £100 to **her daughter Dorothy Penneck**, as well as a bed and furniture, twelve pewter plates, one brass crock, one brass pan, a bell metal skillet, and six chairs.

Gives £100 to her daughter Penelope Nicholls.

Gives 1 guinea each to her four daughters-in-law to buy themselves each a ring.

Gives 1 guinea each to her grandchildren.

Gives to **her three daughters Mary**, **Dorothy** and **Penelope**, all her household linen, clothes, share and share alike.

All the rest of her goods & chattels she gives to **her eldest son John Penneck**, whom she appoints sole executor of her last will and testament.
