Gives and bequeaths £50 to his daughter Blanch.

Gives and bequeaths £50 to his daughter Ann.

Gives and bequeaths 5 shillings to his son-in-law William Blight.

Gives and bequeaths to **his son Richard** his lands, messuages, tenements and stock and makes him sole executor of his last will and testament.
