

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/P/4717 W.

Abstract of the Will of Elizabeth Polkinghorne of the Parish of Tywardreath in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 4 Oct 1830, proved 3 Dec 1831.

Gives £100 to **her daughter Anna Maria Vivian**, to be paid out of her tenement called Looman's Place in Tywardreath.

Gives the said tenement to **her son James Polkinghorne**.

Gives her leasehold tenement called Mount Bennett, also in Tywardreath, to **her three sons John, Joseph and James**, and to her said daughter Anna Maria Vivian, as tenants in common.

Gives her clothing to **her granddaughter Ann Vivian**.

All the rest of her personal estate and effects she gives to her said son James, appointing him sole executor of her will.

Elizabeth Polkinghorne was buried in Tywardreath on 20 Oct 1831, aged 77 years.
