Abstract of the Will of Richard Pryor of Wendron in the County of Cornwall, Tinner, written 6 Aug 1729, proved 26 Sep 1729.

Gives to **his daughter Elizabeth Champion** half a guinea of gold to buy herself a new gown.

Gives two shillings sixpence to **his grandson Richard Champion**.

Gives one guinea of gold to **his son Richard**.

Gives one guinea of gold to **his son John**.

Gives one guinea of gold to **his son William**.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to his wife, making her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
