Gives to his sister Rosea one shilling.

Gives to his sister Catherine one shilling.

Gives to **his sister Frances** £5 to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one.

Gives to his sister Mary £5 to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one.

Gives to **his sister Jone** £5 to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one.

All the rest of his goods and chattels &c. he gives to Henry Penticost, blacksmith, and **Frances Pryor his mother-in-law**\* in trust for **his brother John Pryor** until he comes of age.

Appoints the said Henry Penticost and **Frances Pryor** co-executors of his last will and testament.
