Abstract of the Will of Simon Pryor of the Parish of Wendron in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 3 Aug 1711, proved 15 May 1712.

Gives 2 guineas to **his daughter Philippa** along with the little Trelogin house.

Gives £100 each to **his daughters Elizabeth, Mary and Jone**, to be paid to them when they attain their respective ages of twenty-one years or at their day of marriage.

All the rest of his goods & chattels, rights & credits, he gives to **his wife Philippa Pryor** whom he appoints sole executrix of his last will and testament.

An inventory of the goods, chattels & credits of Simon Pryor late of the parish of Wendron was taken and appraised on 28 Mar 1712 by John Hill and Fra: Hawkins and valued to £630 17s.
