

Abstract of the Will of James Quick of the Borough of St. Ives in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 17 Nov 1765, proved 9 Dec 1765.

Gives his wife his dwelling house in Borallan with the household goods, bedding and furniture, for the term of her natural life.

Gives 1 guinea to **his son James Quick**.

Gives £10 to **his daughter Mary the wife of James Quick** of the parish of Towednack.

Gives £10 each to **his daughters Ann Quick and Jane Quick**, spinsters.

Gives to **his two sons Andrew Quick and Paul Quick** his estate in Borallan, share and share alike.

Gives to **his two other sons, Isaac Quick and Robert Quick** his estate in Trevesia, share and share alike.

All the rest of his real and personal estate he gives to **his wife Mary Quick** and to **his sons Andrew Quick, Paul Quick, Isaac Quick and Robert Quick**.
