

*Abstract of the Will of Robert Quick of the Parish of Towednack in the County of Cornwall, Farmer, written 13 Jun 1809, proved 8 Jul 1809.*

Gives to **his wife Ann Quick** the settlement he made with her on their marriage, along with the use of their lodging room, kitchen, chimney and fowl, and an annuity of £4 for life, to be paid out of his estate of Trevessa Wartha.

Gives to **his son James Quick** his estate in Trevessa Wartha which James currently occupies.

Gives £60 to **his son Robert Quick**.

Gives 2 guineas to **his daughter Willmot Quick**.

Gives 1 guinea to **his daughter-in-law Elizabeth Quick**.

Gives to **his son Paul Quick** his estate in Lower Trevessa and the rest of his goods, chattels and credits, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
