

Abstract of the Will of William Quick of Trevessa in the Parish of Towednack in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 20 Jul 1831, proved 5 Jul 1841.

Gives an annuity of £12 to **his wife Elizabeth Quick**, to be paid out of his estate in Trevessa, along with sufficient furze and turf for her use along with rooms in the higher house.

Gives £1 to **his daughter Elizabeth**.

Gives 1 shilling to **his son William Quick**.

Gives 1 guinea to **his son Paul Quick**.

Gives 1 guinea to **his son Israel Quick**.

Gives £30 to **his daughter Grace**.

Gives £30 to **his daughter Mary**.

Gives to **his son Thomas Quick** his estate in Zennor, Thomas paying £100 to his executors on taking possession thereof.

The rest of his estates he gives to **his two sons James Quick and Robert Quick**, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
