

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/R/4746 W.

Abstract of the Will of Francis Ralph of the Parish of Gwennap in the County of Cornwall, Miner, written 29 Jan 1840, proved 27 May 1853.

Gives all his worldly property, leasehold premises, household furniture, money and securities for money, he gives to **his brother-in-law Joseph Ralph** and to William Downing, schoolmaster, in trust, for the benefit of **his wife Ann Ralph** during her widowhood. If she should re-marry, then he gives the remainder to **his brother-in-law Elisha Ralph**.

Appoints his trustees Joseph Ralph and William Downing co-executors of his last will and testament.
