Abstract of the Will of Richard Raw (Rowe) of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 25 May 1754, proved 17 May 1762.

Gives 1 shilling each to his sons George Raw, James Raw, his daughters Jane the wife of Gilbert Bennetts, Elizabeth the wife of Charles Beckerleg, Anna Raw and Mary Raw.

Gives an annuity of £4 to **his wife Elizabeth Raw**, payable out of his tenement of Bushorne in the parish of Camborne.

Gives an annuity of 20 shillings to **his daughter Barbara Raw** while she remains single, also payable out of his tenement of Bushorne.

Gives to his son Richard Raw land in Bushorne to build a dwelling.

Gives to his son John Raw his right, title and interest in the tenement of Bushorne.

All the rest of his goods and chattels, rights, credits and effects he gives to **his wife Elizabeth Raw**, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
