Gives £10 each to his daughter Alice Burall, widow, and her son Henry Burall.

Gives to **his daughter Jane the wife of George Rowe**, now of the parish of Padstow, his premises & houses called Hallegan Vean in the parish of Crowan.

All the rest of his estates, goods, chattels & effects he gives to **his son Henry Reynolds**, whom he appoints sole executor of his last will and testament.
