

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/R/4602 W.

*Abstract of the Will of Richard Roberts of Boscaswell in the Parish of St. Just in Penwith and County of Cornwall, Miner, written 6 Feb 1842, proved 1 Oct 1847.*

Gives to **his son Richard** one half of his freehold dwelling house and garden in the village of Boscaswell where he now lives, following the death of his wife.

Gives to **his son Thomas** the other half of his freehold dwelling house and garden, following the death of his wife.

Gives 5 shillings each to **his three daughters Mary the wife of Christopher Richards, Elizabeth the wife of Henry Eva, and Jane the wife of John White.**

Gives to **his wife Honor Roberts** his household furniture, farming stock and the dwelling house he now lives in, for the term of her natural life, along with all the rest of his chattels, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
