Abstract of the Will of John Rodda of the Parish of Crowan in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 31 Jan 1760, proved 21 Mar 1760.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son John Rodda**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Mathew Rodda**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son William Rodda**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Mary Kneebone**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Katherane Vivian**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Margaret Pascoe**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Sarah Rodda**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Elizabeth Sems**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter-in-law Jane Rodda**.

Gives to **his wife Kathriane** during her widowhood all his goods, chattels & estate, after which he gives his estate to **his son John Rodda**.

Appoints **his son James Rodda** sole executor and trustee of his will.
