Abstract of the Will of Dorothy Rosewarne of the Parish of Gwinear in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 10 Mar 1835, proved 8 Mar 1839.

Gives to William Vawdrey of the parish of Gwinear, clerk, her dwelling house, meadows, crofts and premises in Gwinear, to be held in trust, for the benefit of **her granddaughter Dorothy Huthnance, child of her daughter Dorothy**. If her said granddaughter should die before her own mother, then in trust for **her daughter Dorothy Huthnance** for life. And after the death of her granddaughter and her granddaughter's mother, then in trust for **her sons Richard, John and Henry** as tenants in common, share and share alike.

Administration of her goods &c was granted to Dorothy Huthnance, the mother and guardian of Dorothy Huthnance, granddaughter of the testatrix.
