Abstract of the Will of George Sampson of the Parish of Breage in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 22 Nov 1741, proved 28 Oct 1742.

Gives an annuity of £6 to **his wife Margaret Sampson**.

Gives to **his son John Sampson** two acres of land in Higher Downs in Redalan in Breage.

Gives £40 to **his daughter Mary the wife of Thomas Thomas**.

Gives £40 to **his daughter Elizabeth Sampson**.

Gives to **his son Richard Sampson** one half of his estate in Redalan an Pengundna in the parish of Breage, reserving to **George Sampson** the Cors field and the Lower Croft. Also gives his son Richard half of his stock and goods.

Appoints **his sons George Sampson and Richard Sampson** co-executors of his last will and testament.
