

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/1330/120.

Abstract of the Will of William Sandys of the Borough of Helston in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 6 Apr 1799, proved 14 Sep 1799.

Gives to his wife his messuages, lands, tenements and estates in St. Keverne and elsewhere, with the yearly income and produce, particularly his estate and interest in the tenement of Trevran in St. Keverne, in trust, to sell and invest the money in securities and receive the interest during her natural life.

Gives to **his sons and sons-in-law William Sandys, Hannibal Sandys, John Trevenen and Richard Whish**, 10 guineas each to buy rings.

Gives to **his daughters Philippa and Mary** the remainder of the money from the sale of his estates, share and share alike, independent of their husbands.

The remainder of his goods, chattels, real and personal estate, he gives to **his wife Mary Sandys** whom he appoints sole executrix of his last will.
