Abstract of the Will of Thomas Sincock of the Parish of Crowan in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 12 Feb 1835, proved 23 Jun 1835.

Gives to **his wife Philipia Sincock** all his household goods, chattels, rents and profits for the term of her natural life.

Gives his clock to **his grandson Thomas Combelack, son of John Combelack by his daughter Grace Combelack.**

Gives £1 to **his grandson Thomas Sincock, the son of his son Thomas Sincock.**

Gives £1 to **his grandson Thomas Sincock, the son of his son William Sincock.**

Appoints **his son-in-law John Combelack** sole executor of his last will and testament.

The remainder of his personal estate he gives to **Thomas Sincock, William Sincock and John Sincock, his three sons**, and to **Ann Roberts the wife of John Roberts, Jane Dunstan the wife of Edward Dunstan, and Grace Combelack the wife of John Combelack, his three daughters.**
