Appoints his son-in-law John Combelack sole executor of his last will and testament.

The remainder of his personal estate he gives to **Thomas Sincock**, **William Sincock** and **John Sincock**, **his three sons**, and to **Ann Roberts the wife of John Roberts**, **Jane Dunstan the wife of Edward Dunstan**, and **Grace Combelack the wife of John Combelack**, **his three daughters**.
