Abstract of the Will of William Skewes of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 14 Nov 1787, proved 22 May 1789.

Gives an annuity of £5 to **his son John Skewes**, to be paid out of his tenement in Treslothan in the parish of Camborne.

Gives to **his son Richard Skewes** his tenement in Treslothan where he now lives, paying the annuity to his brother John.

Gives £10 to his son William Skewes.

Gives 1 shilling to his daughter Mary the wife of Stephen Rowe.

Gives 1 shilling to his daughter Sarah Skewes.

Gives 1 shilling to his son Stephen Skewes.

Gives 1 shilling each to his grandchildren.

All the rest of his goods, chattels & effects he gives to **his son William Skewes**, appointing him the sole executor of his last will and testament, in trust, for **his grandson William Skewes**, **son of his son John Skewes**.
