Abstract of the Will of Jane Tellam of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 10 Jan 1740, proved 12 Jan 1748. [4](#)

Gives an annuity of £5 to **her mother Elizabeth Vivian** for the term of her natural life.

Gives annuities of 40 shillings each to **her sisters Catherine, Isabella, Margaret and Martha**.

Gives £5 each to those of her brothers and sisters who are living at the time of her death.

Gives £5 to **Francis Tellam, son of her brother-in-law Francis Tellam**, to be paid to him when he completes his apprenticeship.

Gives £1 to each of the children of her brothers and sisters alive at her decease.

All the rest of her goods and chattels she gives to **her brother Johnson Vivian**, appointing him sole executor of her will, in trust, for the benefit of **her daughter Elizabeth**, now the **wife of John Trevenen**, Clerk, and their children.
