Abstract of the Will of Mathew Tellam of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, written 12 Aug 1735, proved 13 May 1736.

Gives £1 5s. to **his sister-in-law Margrit Vivian**.

Gives £1 5s. to **his sister-in-law Martha Vivian**.

Gives £1 1s. to **Mary the daughter of John Vivian**.

Gives £2 2s. to **Catrin Evea**.

Gives to **his brother John Tellam's** children £1 1s.

Gives £1 1s. to **his aunt Jane Hartt**.

Gives to **his brother Christopher Tellam's** children £1 1s.

Gives to **his brother Richard Tellam's** child £1 1s.

Gives to **his brother Frank Tellam's** two sons £30.

Gives all of his goods and chattels to **his wife Jane Tellam** and **his daughter Elizabeth Tellam**, appointing them co-executrices, his wife to receive an annuity of £6.

Appoints **his brother-in-law Johnson Vivian** of the borough of Truro and John Richards of Crowan, guardians of his personal estate during the minority of his daughter Elizabeth.
