

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/T/3459 W, Inv.

Abstract of the Will of John Temby of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman & Tinner, written 27 Mar 1797, proved 20 May 1800.

Gives 5 shillings each to **his four grandchildren, children of James Goldsworthy**, along with all his wearing apparel.

Gives to **his daughter Mary, the wife of the said James Goldsworthy**, one bullock and an annuity of 40 shillings to be paid out of his premises in Laity in the parish of Camborne. He further gives her an annuity of 20 shillings to be paid out of his premises in Stennack in Camborne.

Gives to **his daughter Margery Temby** all his household furniture.

All the rest of his estates and effects he gives to **his daughter Margery** and to **his daughter Elizabeth the wife of Henry Roberts**, appointing them co-executrices of his last will and testament.
