Gives to **his wife Susannah** his five best beds with their furnishings and bedding, all his household furniture, linen, china, plate, liquor &c., as well as the use of his dwelling house in Veryan along with various fields and closes of land.

All the rest of his estates real and personal he gives and bequeaths to **his niece**Mary Collins the wife of Edward Collins, Esq., appointing her the sole executrix of his last will and testament.
