Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Ann Holman** and twelve pence to **her husband John Holman**. Gives **his granddaughter Ann Holman** his red heifer, and twelve pence each to **his grandchildren John Holman and Margery Holman**.

Gives 10 shillings to his sister Paskes Williams.

All the rest of his goods, leases, lands and tenements he gives to **his son John Tocker**, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.

Nominates Ralfe Goulsery and Richard Harries as trustees and overseers.
