Abstract of the Will of Nicholas Tredinnick of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Mine Agent, written 10 Aug 1850, proved 19 Jul 1855.

Appoints John Rule of Park Bracket in the parish of Camborne, Esquire, executor of his will, giving to him his freehold estates and personal property, in trust, for the use of **his wife Mary** and **his** (youngest) **daughters Mary and Hannah Jones** while they remain unmarried.

On 9 May 1855 the said executor, John Rule of Park Bracket, Esquire, renounced executorship, directing that Administration of the goods, chattels & credits of Nicholas Tredinnick be granted to Mary Tredinnick his widow.
