*Abstract of the Nuncupative Will of Thomas Tregidgeon of the Parish of Veryan in the County of Cornwall, Labourer, written 10 Jun 1656, proved 7 Feb 1656/7.*

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Thomas Tregidgeon**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Luke Tregidgeon**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Mary Tregidgeon**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Anne Tregidgeon**.

Gives 2 shillings sixpence to **his brother's children William, Robert, Mary and Elizabeth Tregidgeon**.\*

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his wife Pascas** whom he makes sole executrix of his last will and testament.
